The small size of Blue Lagoon Cruises' ship, M.V. Fiji Princess, helps make a cruise with us so special. Measuring 179 feet (55 metres), she can access bays and islands that would be impossible to reach in a larger ship, getting so close to shore that we tie off to a coconut tree and you can swim to the beach! Our cruises are adults only (other than our listed family departures) and with a maximum of 68 passengers and up to 30 Fijian crew,

you know you will be well looked after. The vessel's decor is fresh and nautical, with echoes of the romantic age of cruising gone by. You only need to unpack once and then let your floating hotel take you from idyllic place to idyllic experience – every day somewhere and something different. Visit traditional Fijian villages, swim in crystal-clear lagoons and gaze out on tropical vistas you thought only existed in the movies.

FRIDAY - 1st night: Modriki Island

SATURDAY - 2nd night: Soso Bay


Before breakfast, plunge into Modriki's crystal-clear lagoon or wander along its white sandy beach. Spend your morning swimming with reef sharks (weather permitting) and in the afternoon, visit the chiefly village of Soso. Dinner is a traditional Thali dinner, with Bollywood dancing and movies to follow.

SUNDAY - 3rd night: Naukacuvu Island

Those that wish to can attend a village church service in the morning and have a relaxed afternoon at the beach. Learn to cook a traditional Fijian recipe and enjoy a buffet dinner of Fijian cuisine along with a choice of European dishes before the evening entertainment.

MONDAY - Sacred Islands

Today you'll have time for an early-morning snorkel or swim. During breakfast we'll cruise to the Sacred Islands and after lunch, you'll be farewelled by the crew and transferred back to Port Denarau on our private high-speed catamaran.

Wanderer Cruise - 5 days/4 nights

Wander the white sandy beaches of the Yasawas

MONDAY - 1st night: Yalobi Bay

Transfer to the Sacred Islands via our private highspeed catamaran and set sail on M.V. Fiji Princess. Settle into your cabin and have lunch on the ship, then spend your afternoon snorkelling, swimming and relaxing on the beach. Enjoy a complimentary glass of sparkling wine and canapés as you mix and mingle with your fellow cruisers prior to the à la carte Captain's Welcome Dinner.

TUESDAY - 2nd night: Blue Lagoon

Visit the famous Blue Lagoon and our own private beach on beautiful Nanuya Lailai Island where M.V. Fiji Princess will tie off to a coconut tree! Optional activities include snorkelling, fish feeding, volleyball, water aerobics and a coconut husking demonstration. A BBQ lunch will be served on the beach while tonight's dinner is a traditional Fijian Lovo (a meal cooked underground in a fire pit) and entertainment is a Meke performance by local villagers.

WEDNESDAY - 3rd night: Sawa-I-Lau

Enjoy an easy workout this morning with a 40-minute guided trek to Lo's Tea Shop on the other side of the island and either walk back to M.V. Fiji Princess or travel

by tender boat. We then cruise north to swim in the sacred Sawa-I-Lau Caves. Visit to Tamasua Village where you'll enjoy a traditional village dinner. Back on board, watch the Brooke Shields' classic film The Blue Lagoon on the sky deck (weather permitting) which was filmed right here in the Yasawa Islands.

THURSDAY - 4th night: Drawaga Island

Visit a local school before we head south for Drawaqa Island where a marine biologist will join us on board to talk to us about the marine life, coral reefs and the conservation programmes that the Vinaka Fiji Trust are working on in the Yasawas. This afternoon you can go diving (additional cost), handline fishing, go in search of the manta rays (May-Oct) or simply relax on the beach. For our last night together, we'll have a BBQ on the sky deck (weather permitting) followed by a disco. Boogie on down!

FRIDAY

Enjoy breakfast on board as M.V. Fiji Princess cruises back to Port Denarau. At port you'll be serenaded with the traditional Isa Lei farewell song by the crew, as your exploration of the beautiful Yasawa Islands comes to an end.

Escape to Paradise - 8 days/7 nights

Discover the tropics with a week in paradise

FRIDAY - 1st night: Modriki Island

Set sail on M.V. Fiji Princess from Port Denarau for the outer Mamanuca Islands with the first overnight anchorage being the picturesque Modriki Island, the location for the Tom Hanks movie Cast Away. Enjoy a glass of sparkling wine and canapés as you watch the sunset followed by the à la carte Captain's Welcome Dinner and be entertained by our talented singing and guitar-playing crew.

SATURDAY - 2nd night: Soso Bay

Step ashore and enjoy a swim or wander along the beach at Modriki before or after breakfast. Swim with reef sharks at Mouva Reef en route to our next destination and after lunch, we take a visit to the chiefly village of Soso. Tonight, feast on a traditional Thali dinner of exquisite Indian dishes, followed by an extravaganza of Bollywood dancing.

SUNDAY - 3rd night: Naukacuvu Island

After breakfast attend a village church service. Watch as the Chef demonstrates how to make the traditional Fijian dish Kokoda and spend the afternoon at the beach. Tonight's buffet has a range of dishes from Fiji along with a choice of European dishes. This evenings entertainment is Fijian-style bingo.

MONDAY - 4th night: Yalobi Bay

Admire the stunning Sacred Islands and backdrop of the neighbouring Waya Lailai's breath taking volcanic formations. Spend the remainder of the day swimming, snorkelling and relaxing on the beach and watch the Chef demonstrate how to make the Roti in Lolo dish. Watch the sunset and enjoy tonight's Captain's Welcome Dinner welcoming the 4-night guests on board.

TUESDAY - 5th night: Blue Lagoon

Our destination today is the famed Blue Lagoon and our own private beach where we can tie M.V. Fiji Princess off to a coconut tree! Jump off the back into the turquoise waters or take a tender boat to shore where our full bar awaits you. Today's activities include snorkelling, fish feeding, non-motorised water sports, water aerobics and volleyball. Dine on the beach all day today, including morning and afternoon tea, a buffet-style lunch and a traditional Lovo meal cooked underground for dinner under the stars, followed by a traditional Meke performance by the local villagers.

WEDNESDAY - 6th night: Sawa-I-Lau

Enjoy panoramic views of the Blue Lagoon if you join our easy 40-minute guided walk to the other side of the island to visit Lo's Tea House. Lunch is served on board as M.V. Fiji Princess cruises north for a private guided visit to the amazing Sawa-I-Lau Caves. Afterwards the village of Tamasua welcomes us for a Yaqona (Kava) ceremony, a guided walk around the village and a village-style dinner.

THURSDAY - 7th night: Drawaqa Island

Visit the local island school before cruising to Drawaqa Island where a marine biologist joins us on board for a presentation on the local marine life and the volunteer conservation work carried out in the area.

You'll have the opportunity to snorkel with the magnificent manta rays (May-October) or go on a guided reef snorkel. Dinner this evening is a BBQ on the sky deck (weather permitting) served under the stars. After our last dinner together, we party Fiji-style!



Getting ready for your cruise

Blue Lagoon Cruises cater for people of all ages and fitness levels, although you do have to be able to make your way up and down steep staircases. While getting in and out of the tender boats can require a certain degree of mobility, the crew will tailor the shore landings to suit and there's nothing wrong with staying on board for those that would prefer to relax and enjoy the scenery. On or off the ship, the Blue Lagoon Cruises team will ensure that you will have a truly memorable experience.

The dress code is casual and informal, even at dinner. We encourage our guests to wear what they feel comfortable in and to leave their dinner jackets and high heels at home. For those wanting to visit villages, for cultural reasons, we do ask that men wear a sulu (provided in your cabin) and women dress modestly with shoulders and knees covered.
